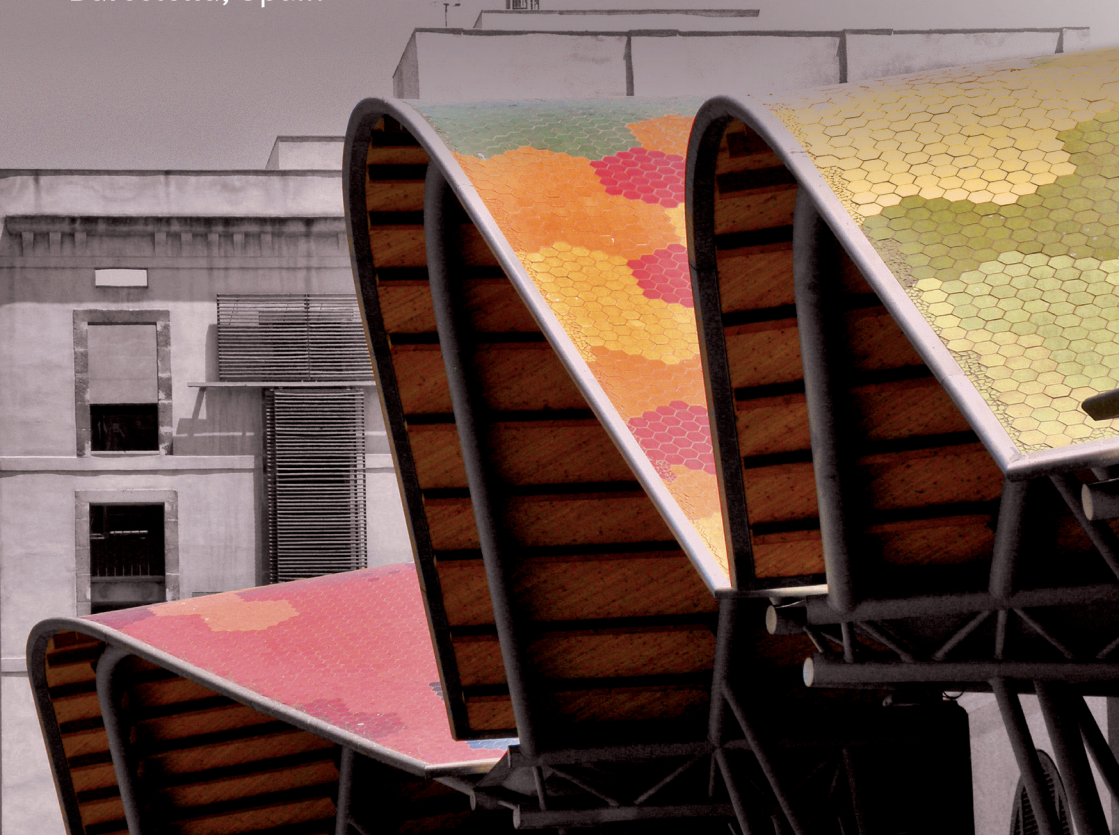

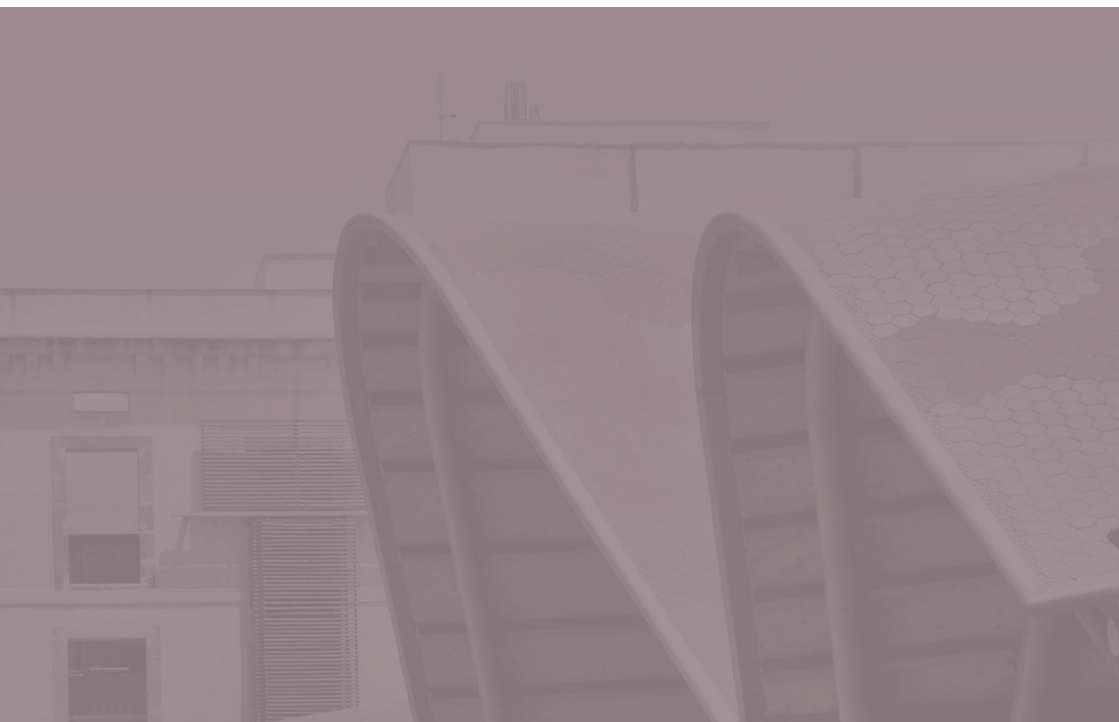

### **Visa**
